

# Pool Rules

- 1) **All members, each family member and guest must register (name and club number) upon entry to the pool area. Each guest must be accompanied by a member. A guest charge will be applied to the member's account. A member's account will be accessed for failing to register a guest.**
- 2) **Lifeguards will be present during operating hours, however, the Club assumes no liability for the safety of anyone using the pool or its facilities. The lifeguards will be in charge of the pool area with authority to enforce all rules including limiting the activities of anyone disturbing others.**
- 3) **Under no circumstances is the pool to be used unless a lifeguard, who is employed by the Club, is present and on duty.**
- 4) **Only proper bathing attire will be permitted in the pool. Cut-offs and other similar dress will not be allowed. Crocs shoes are strictly prohibited in the pool area.**
- 5) **All swimmers are requested to shower before entering the pool.**
- 6) **Food must be eaten in the designated areas..... Not the pool area. Please dispose of your trash. Only food or drinks purchased from the Club may be consumed on Club property.**
- 7) **No one with fever, cold, inflamed eyes, skin disease, or other infectious diseases will be allowed to use the pool.**
- 8) **Running and roughness in the pool area will not be tolerated.**
- 9) **Children, under the age of twelve and not accompanied by an adult, must pass an approved swim test administered by the Club lifeguard in order to be admitted to the pool area.**
- 10) **The wading pool is for small children, those primarily under the age of six, only. Their safety is the sole responsibility of the parent(s).**
- 11) **The Club accepts no responsibility for valuables or other articles left in the locker rooms or around the pool area. Lost and Found will be located in the pool office during swim season.**
- 12) **Any rules violation may result in suspension of pool privileges for the remaining portion of the swim season.**
